PURPOSE OF ROLE

To promote student participation in sporting activities, including local, regional and national competition, for the purposes of growing shared interest communities, promoting a healthy student lifestyle and providing valuable extra-curricular opportunities for members.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Student Groups

- To provide students with the opportunity to create and join sports-related shared-interest student groups
- To support the setting up and maintenance of shared-interest student groups
- Working with colleagues, to promote student group opportunities throughout the membership, in particular at key times of year, such as induction and refreshers
- To ensure all sports-related student groups operate in line with AberSU policies and values, including specifically health and safety provision
- To ensure appropriate insurances are held and related processes and policies followed to protect AberSU and members in relation to student groups' activities
- To keep and maintain an effective database of membership, reporting on levels of participation
- To work with AU colleagues in facilities management to provide access to facilities required for student groups activities

2. BUCS & Competitive Sport

- To be the lead staff facilitator of local, regional and national competitive sports participation, including particularly BUCS events
- Working with AU colleagues and other partners, ensure provision of appropriate sporting facilities to host 'home' games/matches
- Work with BUCS colleagues to ensure effective and efficient management of AberSU resources
- To liaise with and attend BUCS (and other) networking and influencing forums

3. Leadership Training & Development

- To promote volunteer student group leadership opportunities as beneficial for career and student experience
- To support sports groups to elect their committee membership as per AberSU policies
- To develop and deliver, with key colleagues, an annual scheme of student group leader training to equip leaders with the skills and resources necessary to do a great job for their groups
- To support relevant elected officers to represent sports/activities students

4. Student Community Engagement

- To promote the principle of student community engagement throughout the department's activities, noting the value established by a sense of belonging.
- To develop the AberSU commitment to volunteering to include student group leaders.
- To support major student community events such as Aber7's and Super Teams, working with other departments as appropriate.

5. Other Duties:

- To attend meetings, conferences and training events that may support the effective achievement of the above tasks, and which may promote AberSU's interests, locally, regionally and nationally.
- To positively promote and uphold the values and policies of AberSU.
- To be an advocate for AberSU and our work, locally, regionally and nationally as opportunities arise.
- To work within the terms of the governing documents of the Union, principally the Constitution.
- To contribute to Students' Union publications and informational materials.
- To uphold reasonable expectations regarding health and safety, data protection and other relevant regulations and legislation as appropriate.
- To assist in key Students' Union events throughout the year including Welcome Week & Elections

- Have a flexible approach to duties and work and, in particular, adopt a teamwork style with departments and activities across the Union. This may involve undertaking duties in support of the activities and services of other departments
- Environmental consideration and environmental best practice is the responsibility of all Students' Union staff
- To contribute to Union projects and participate in working groups
- To demonstrate Students' Union behaviours & standards in daily working life
