





What is a Trustee?

"An individual person or member of a board given control or powers of administration of property in trust with a legal obligation to administer it solely for the purposes specified."


You would be held responsible if anything bad happened. It sounds scary - this is very unlikely but it is to show how important you are if anything bad happened.

All trustees on the board have a shared responsibility for the healthy and sustainable running of the organisation. You are responsible for checking over the budgets and making sure we are not losing money as well as making sure all events and activities are safe and properly risk assessed to limit potential injuries.



What is a Trustee? - Undeb Aber

"Your Union is governed and strategically led by the Board of Trustees. They are ultimately responsible for making sure that we operate in line with our charitable objectives. AberSU Trustee Board is made up of 12 members and meets at least four times a year to carry out its business on behalf of you"

Chair of the Board of Trustee

The President of the Student's Union is the chair of the Board of Trustees

Their Role:

- **Keep the structure of the meeting.**
- **Keep the pace of the meeting flowing.**
- **Allow everyone to speak and share their mind.**
- **Make sure all members are being treated with respect.**
- **Keep order and make sure only one person speaks at a time.**
- **Keep discussions on topic.**
- **Highlighting proposals that are made in the meeting summarising what committee members have said.**
- **Summarise what has been said and indicate clear decision.**
- **Help find common ground with opposing views.**
- **Clarifying what members are voting on and casting a vote in the event of a tie**

A good chair is someone who allows people to contribute, ensures everyone understands the discussion and gets a decision made within the time available. A chair should understand the constitution and the rules relating to meetings, understanding how structured those meetings should be.

Democracy



Board of Trustees

Meets 4 or 5x per year includes FTOs, Students and Externals.

Big Meeting

Held once per year and open to all members – also known as AGM.

Senedd

Meets 4x per year and sets Policy of the Union

Forums

Split into four (Wellbeing, Academic Affairs, Sports, Societies) and chaired by relevant officer.

Forums

Each of the Officers will have an evening where students can come and ask any questions or talk about anything related to that officer.

If you have ideas they can either be a quick fix or the Officer will suggest the idea goes to Senedd for students to vote on.

The Officers will have a couple of questions that they will ask you and then will answer any questions

Each Officer will be accompanied by a full-time SU Staff member to help with any questions they may not know the answers to and to take notes.



Submitting an idea to Senedd or Quick Fix

Anyone can submit an idea and it will go to either a quick fix or it will be voted on at Senedd or AGM.

If voted for, the full-time officers will take them as policies to work on.

What is an Idea?

An Idea is what we call a submission from any student that asks AberSU to:

- Start a new activity
- Stop or change a current activity
- Adopt or change a stance
- Update or change current Policy

...and much more! An Idea could be anything, as long as it effects Aberystwyth Students.



Is there a 'Quick Fix'?

Sometimes we get an idea that has easy solutions and no opposition.

A few examples could include:

- Ideas that have no major political or financial implications.
- Requests to change the way we present certain information, or to make more information available e.g. website resources
- A simple request to make a small change to the building e.g. signage
- A request that doesn't relate directly to AberSU, but we can raise the issue in relevant committees with the University e.g. changes to commercial services

Of course there won't be a 'quick fix' for every idea, and we will always work with the submitter to ensure they are happy with the outcomes.

Structure

Senedd

Chaired by the Volunteer Chair Person

Only Senedd members can vote on policies.

- 1. The Full-time Officers will do an update on what they have been working on.**
- 2. Ideas that have been submitted are announced - the person who submits the idea explains why - Senedd Members split into groups to discuss - Senedd members vote on the policy.**



AGM (The Big Meeting)

**Needs to have 100 students
there for the meeting to go
ahead!**

Structure

- 1. Full-time Officers will give a overview of what they have been working on.**
- 2. CEO goes through the Unions accounts.**
- 3. Students agree/disagree to affiliations**
- 4. Policy ideas submitted (Similar to Senedd)**


**They meet every quarter
(Twice a term)**




This is where all the policies votes on go to for final approval.
